

## Client fees for basic education Morning and Afternoon Clubs

In Turku, the client fee principles of basic education Morning and Afternoon Clubs are grounded in the Basic Education Act section 48 f, and the decisions of the Education Committee.

### Monthly fee

The Morning and Afternoon Clubs require a monthly fee. Starting from 1 Aug 2018, the fees are

- 11 am–15 pm afternoon club (max. 760 h / school year) 92 € per month
- 11 am–17 pm afternoon club (over 760 h / school year) 110 € per month
- morning club 40 € per month

The fee is charged for every month that the child attends a morning or afternoon club. For August, the fee is charged as half.

If the school year continues up to June, no fee will be charged for that time.

### The effect of absences on the fee

When a child is not able to attend morning and afternoon clubs for over 10 days in a calendar month because of an illness, only half of the fee is charged. If absence due to an illness lasts a whole calendar month, no fee is charged.

If a child does not attend the club(s) for a whole calendar month for another reason, the monthly fee is charged as half.

### Discharging of or reducing the client fee

For reducing the fee or discharging of it, a separate application from the guardian is required.

The decision about reducing the client fee by 25 per cent or discharging of it can be made from the beginning of the month during which the application with its attachments has arrived in the Education Division of the City of Turku. The decision will be valid max. until the end of the school year in question.

## Basic education Morning and Afternoon Clubs

The considered size of the family consists of the persons living in a marriage or a marriage-like arrangement in a cohabiting household, and the underage kids of them both, living in the same household. If needed, the information is checked in the Population Register.

When the client fee is reduced or discharged, the considered income consists of the taxable earned and unearned income and tax-free income of the cohabiting child, parent or other guardian, and the person living with them in the same household in a marriage or a marriage-like arrangement. In case the income of the family changes after the decision, or the size of the family increases, it has to be reported to the Education Division of the City of Turku. Allowed reductions or discharges of the client fee that are based on incorrect information can be charged back from the client in arrears.
