

TO THE ATTENTION OF CITIZENS OF UKRAINE ARRIVING TO FINLAND BECAUSE OF THE RUSSIAN ATTACK

Residence in Finland

- You should apply for temporary protection in Finland
 - Contact the foreign citizens' investigative unit of Southwestern Finland Police Department: Raisio Police Station, Nallikatu 8, Raisio, telephone number +358 295 444 818, ulkomaalaistutkinta.lounais-suomi@poliisi.fi, on weekdays from 8 am to 4 pm
 - Temporary protection shall be granted to the following persons who have resided in and left Ukraine after the beginning of the major Russian attack on 24 February 2022:
 - Ukrainian citizens and their family members
 - Those who received international protection in Ukraine and their family members
 - Other permanent residents of Ukraine who are unable to return to their home country
 - Additionally, temporary protection in Finland is granted to
 - Ukrainian citizens and their family members who fled Ukraine shortly before 24 February 2022 and cannot return as a result of the conflict
 - Other Ukrainian citizens already residing in Finland or who have arrived in Finland and their family members
 - Citizens of non-EU countries legally residing (permanently or otherwise) in Ukraine who cannot return to their home country
 - Beneficiaries of temporary protection are entitled to
 - live in a reception centre (or they can organise their own living arrangements)
 - health care services and essential social welfare services
 - secure the necessary means of subsistence
 - work
- If you have a valid biometric passport, you can stay in Finland for 90 days without a visa or residence permit
 - If you need urgent support for food, medicine or similar, you can apply for urgent social assistance from the Social Insurance Institution of Finland (KELA): www.kela.fi
- You can also seek asylum in Finland
 - Contact the foreign citizens' investigative unit of Southwestern Finland Police Department
