



The purpose of the Accompaniment Card is to help persons with disabilities or chronic illnesses to participate in exercise and cultural events. The card entitles one person to free admission to accompany the card holder at municipal sports facilities and cultural attractions. Two cards may be issued to persons with severe disabilities who have a legitimate need for two assistants.

- Turku residents and persons permanently residing in Turku can apply for an Accompaniment Card with this form
- The application form must include a statement from a social or health care professional (e.g. doctor, physiotherapist, rehabilitation counsellor, occupational therapist, social worker, nurse, etc.) on the need for an escort or a copy of the latest rehabilitation report, service plan or visual impairment card (Finnish Federation of the Visually Impaired). For children with a special or enhanced support administrative decision, the card can be applied for in cooperation with the day care center.
- The card is valid for up to five years

4 Purposes of processing personal data	Personal data is processed to the extent permitted by applicable law to ensure that the customer is entitled to an assistant. In addition, the contact information can be used to inform the data subject about the services of the Accompaniment Card and applied sports.
5 Personal data included in the register	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – the first and last name and year of birth of the customer – address – telephone number – e-mail – the social or health care professional’s assessment of the need for assistance reported in the application form. <p>The data in separate reports and assessments attached to the application (e.g. a copy of the visual impairment card or a rehabilitation or service plan) that is considered relevant to the issuance of the Accompaniment Card shall be recorded in the register when the card is issued. The customer may choose to conceal information from the statements that is not necessary for the issuance of the Accompaniment Card. Separate reports and assessments attached to the application will be returned to the customer once the Accompaniment Card has been posted.</p> <p>The data shall be stored for 10 years.</p>
6 Regular data sources	Personal data are collected from the data subjects.
7 Regular disclosure of data	The personal data are not disclosed to third parties.
8 Transfer of data outside the EU or the EEA	The personal data are not transferred outside the EU or the EEA.
9 Principles of safeguarding the register	<p>A. Manual material Paper application forms are stored in folders in a locked cabinet.</p> <p>B. Data to be processed by ADP Personal data (first and last name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and year of birth) and information on the validity of the Accompaniment Card are stored in a database that is protected by firewalls, passwords and other technical means. Only designated persons have access to the database.</p>
