Service voucher	The municipality uses a service voucher arrangement to provide early childhood education services as an alternative to municipal services. Service vouchers can be issued to children who are eligible for day care services and use the services of private day care centres. Issuing a service voucher is based on the assessment of the child's need for day care. Day care service vouchers are issued individually to each child. It is not possible to receive both private care allowance and home care allowance for arranging the child's care at the same time. The value of the income-based service voucher depends on the child's age, weekly care hours and the family's level of income. The value of the service voucher is the determined by subtracting the euro amount the family would pay for municipal day care services from the price cap. The deductible the customer is responsible for is the difference between the day care fee charged by the provider and the value of the service voucher.
